participated in the YMCA Alternative Suspension program

The Alternative Suspension program helps youth between 12 and 17 years of age who are facing temporary suspension from their academic institution or are at risk of suspension following problematic behaviour.

The program aims to reduce the number of repeated suspensions by offering youth the chance to transform their period of suspension into a positive experience fostering personal development and autonomy, mostly by:

- Placing them in an environment focused on building self-worth
- > Developing social skills
- Promoting self-respect and respect for others

The 2024–2025 year marks a major milestone for the YMCA's Alternative Suspension program, now Back on Track by the YMCA. Celebrating 25 years of dedication, the program embraces a new identity that better reflects its mission of prevention, support, and reintegration. Under this new banner we are proud to continue foster student perseverance and academic success across Canada and beyond.

## > Our Impact

Following their participation in the program, youth demonstrate improved behaviour, aptitudes, and academic success. Thanks to the ongoing monitoring of the program over the past year, we observed:

**A 27% reduction** in the overall severity of behaviours.

A 63 % improvment in their overall situation at school.

**Nearly 70 % of youth** program participants were not suspended again.

**Nearly 86 % stated** that they better understood the reason for their suspension.

A 65 % reduction in disciplinary measures.

We're proud to have collaborated with over 45 School Boards/School Divisions.
